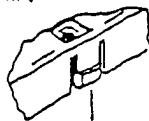

GENERAL INFORMATION

There are two parts to the Duragrid locking system.



The Male Peg

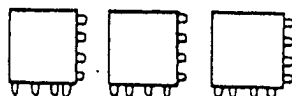


The Female Loop

All tiles on any given installation should ALWAYS HAVE THE FEMALE LOOPS GOING IN THE SAME DIRECTION. (illustration 1)

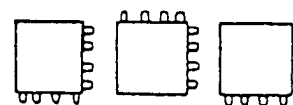
CAUTION: If you inadvertently rotate a tile 90° it will snap into place (illustration 2) but you will not be able to complete the installation properly.

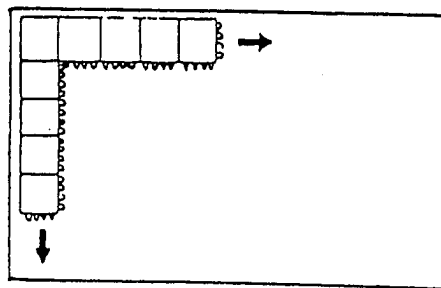
Wrong

It is important that all debris be removed from the underlying surface before laying Duragrid so there are no lumps, this is especially important for playing surfaces. In cases of irregularity in the surface, fill or grind down the surface to bring it as level as possible.

ASSEMBLY

Always begin the installation in one corner, pointing the female loops in the directions that additional tiles are to be added.
